
We are furnishing you a copy of memorandum dated 31 May 2012 signed by Commissioner Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon of the Bureau of Customs regarding the above subject matter.

For those companies who are not yet registered with the Bureau of Customs' Client Profile Registration System (CPRS) and have not completed the prerequisites to AEDS processing, kindly please coordinate with your respective Value Added Service Providers (VASPs) as soon as possible.

Effective 1 June 2012, e2M AEDS will be implemented with a 10-day transition period to give chance to companies to register with BOC CPRS. On 11 June 2012, e2M AEDS processing will be strictly enforced by the BOC without exceptions.

SUBJECT : Implementation of E2M Automated Export Documentation System with TRANSITION PERIOD

As previously announced, this is to once again enjoin all exporters who have complied with the e2m accreditation procedure to please have their export declarations processed through the e2m AEDS effective 1 June 2012.

On the other hand, the Bureau of Customs, responsive to the appeal of some sectors, has agreed to a 10-day transition period to allow those who have not completed the prerequisites to AEDS processing to comply with all the requirements. During the 10-day transition period, those with pending requirements will be allowed manual processing of their export transactions.

Effective 11 June 2012, the end of the 10-day transition period, e2m AEDS processing will be strictly enforced without exceptions.

The cooperation of all concerned greatly appreciated.
